


# County System Example Case in Martin County

"You are only registered with 'William McKenna' therefore you will only receive notification when the recording lists that specifically."

The county suggested registering for **multiple name variations**, such as:

- William N. McKenna IV
- William N McKenna
- William McKenna
- Full middle name spelled out



#### This approach is:


- Cumbersome: Most homeowners don't think to register multiple name versions.
- Inconsistent: Human error in document recording may lead to alert failure.
- Insufficient: Important filings like second mortgages can slip through undetected.
- Homeowner's second loan went unnoticed because the alert system failed to recognize his full legal name format.
- Common names will not be accurate.
- Names with commons, suffixes, periods and space will not be caught.
- Over-reporting and under-reporting using owners name not tracking on the parcel nor address
